CO- OP Program Requirements

Step 1: You must distribute 250 of Operation Resources pamphlets before your personal deadline and Operation Resources will issue you a check for \$250.00. There is no charge for the pamphlets once you have been chosen for a scholarship.

Step 2: Once you have earned your first \$250 scholarship you must turn in your official transcripts from your current semester of college showing you have maintained a GPA of 2.5(C+) or better. To be eligible for the additional \$250.00 for your first year. You must write a follow up essay on how you distributed the pamphlets and how the first half of your scholarship has aided your education. Upon completion of your essay Operation Resources Inc. will issue your second half of your scholarship bringing your total to \$500. Once you have completed this portion you may repeat step 1 for a maximum of \$1000 for your first year.
